Dear parents,

We hope everyone had an enjoyable summer break and are ready and excited to return to school on Thursday, September 1st! Students from Senior Infants to Sixth class will be in school for the full school day.

We will follow the same drop off and collection procedures that were in place during the past school year. Reception time is from **8.45-9am** or 8.30-9am on wet mornings. Please see attached a list of the entry/exit doors for the children's new classrooms and teachers. We will continue with minimum movement of people and minimum socialisation at school drop off and collection time.

Please bring Senior Infants and 1<sup>st</sup> class children to their entry door where school staff will be present to guide the students to their classrooms. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> class parents please use your own discretion initially regarding drop off and pick up from the school grounds or meeting points. We expect 4th- 6<sup>th</sup> class students to enter and exit the school grounds independently.

Please collect Senior Infants from their exit doors at **1.30pm** and 1<sup>st</sup> class at the slightly earlier time of **2.20pm until Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**. Collection time for 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> class is 2.30pm.

We encourage parents and students to walk, scoot, cycle or park 'n stride to school each day so that we maintain the fabulous record we set over the past two years.

All students wear their school uniform to school on Thursday. P.E. day details will be emailed by the class teachers later next week. Playball staff will be providing P.E. classes again this year for the junior classes and Kieran Keenan will be the P.E. teacher for the senior classes. **Please ensure that school jumpers/ cardigans and tracksuit tops are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.**

**We are aware that some schoolbooks are out of stock so please reassure your child that we fully understand if they haven't all their books on day one!** Class teachers will be in contact with you later next week with any specific requests relevant to their class. Please encourage your child to check that they have their books/copies and lunch in their schoolbag each morning. Should you need to collect your child during the school day, please email the office to arrange collection from the school reception area.

**If your child is feeling unwell or is displaying Covid-19 symptoms, we ask that you continue to adhere to DES / HSE guidelines and that a student should not come to school.**

Many thanks in advance for your cooperation with all of the above. We look forward to a happy and successful Carysfort experience for students, parents and school staff for the 2022-'23 academic year!
